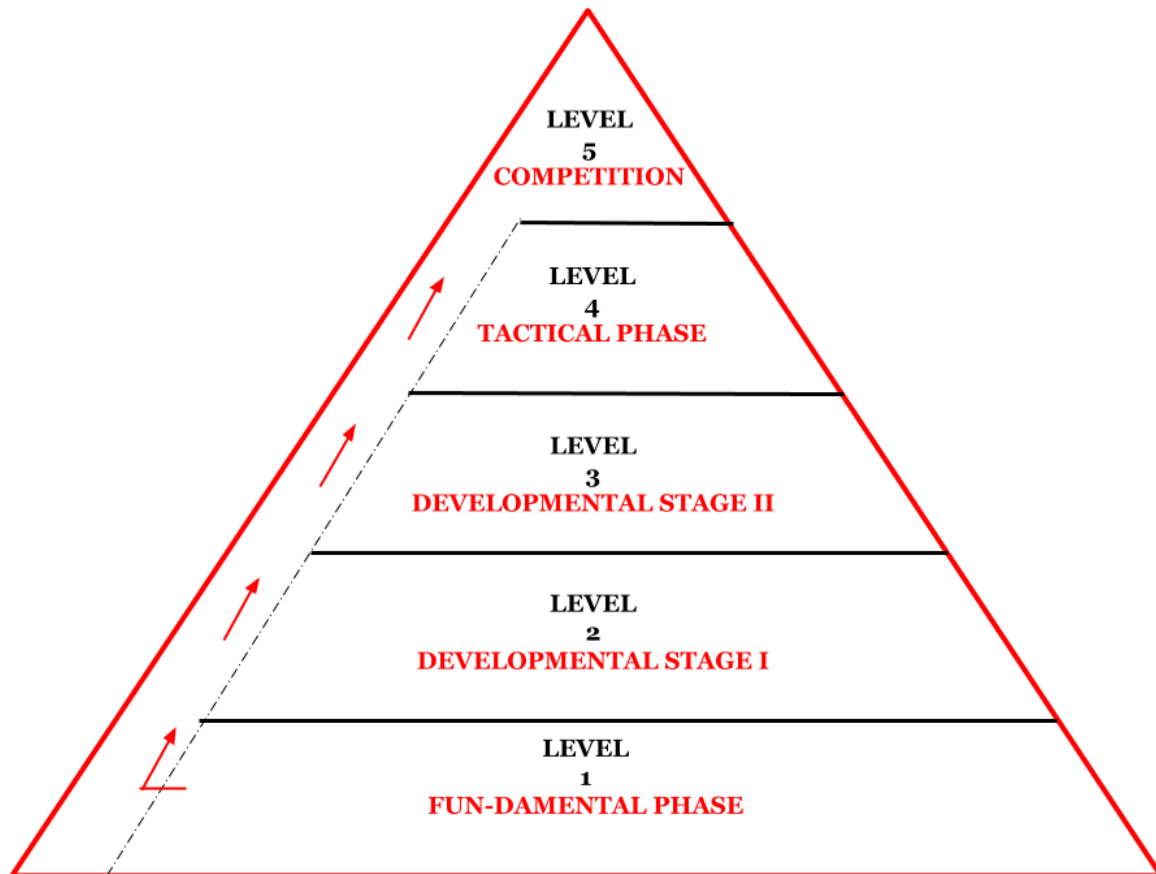
What Has Stones River FC Been Up to This Year?
